Resolution Adding \$140,300 in American Rescue Act Plan Funds to the Salvation Army Roadway Reimbursement Contract

LEGISLATIVE INTENT/PURPOSE:

WHEREAS, in 2024, the Salvation Army of Wilmington (“Salvation Army”) and the City entered into an Agreement to provide \$1,300,000 of American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”) funding as a reimbursement for the construction of a roadway; and,

WHEREAS, the qualifiable costs for reimbursement for the Project from the City to the Salvation Army exceeded the \$1,300,000 originally agreed upon; and,

WHEREAS, the qualifiable costs of reimbursement for the Project to the Salvation Army totaled \$1,464,757.60 due to unforeseen circumstances that include increased construction costs; and,

WHEREAS, the City has a surplus of ARPA funds from other projects with funds allocated prior to December 31, 2024, that came in under budget; and,

WHEREAS, ARPA funds may be reallocated between other obligated projects pursuant to certain terms and conditions, which include that the recipient’s project funds were obligated prior to December 31, 2024, that the funds will be used for the same contracted project, that the project experienced unforeseen costs, and that the governing board approved the reallocation in a budget amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to reallocate the aforementioned surplus ARPA funds to the Salvation Army for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, this is the same Project originally contemplated and agreed upon in the contract.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT, the City Manager is hereby authorized to add \$140,300 in surplus ARPA funding to the Salvation Army Roadway Reimbursement Project and to execute all necessary documents to accomplish the same.
