Resolution Declaring Fifty-Two Motorola Radios Surplus Property to be Donated to the Town of Holly Ridge and to New Hanover County

LEGISLATIVE INTENT/PURPOSE:

WHEREAS, the Town of Holly Ridge requested assistance in the form of five (5) Motorola radios and associated equipment for use by their officers; and,

WHEREAS, New Hanover County requested assistance in the form of forty-seven (47) Motorola radios and associated equipment for use by the North Carolina Joint Urban Search and Rescue Team; and,

WHEREAS, City staff identified fifty-two (52) Motorola surplus radios that were recently replaced with the FY26 radio replacement project; and,

WHEREAS, the property identified for surplus and donation has an estimated total fair market value of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000), and shall be used solely by the Town of Holly Ridge and by New Hanover County for a public purpose in which the Town and County are authorized by law to engage; and,

WHEREAS, the donation of the surplus equipment is allowed pursuant to N.C.G.S. Chapter 160A-280(a).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT, fifty-two (52) Motorola radios are hereby declared surplus property, with five (5) to be donated to the Town of Holly Ridge and forty-seven (47) to be donated to New Hanover County.

THAT, the City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to donate the surplus property described in this resolution.
